★ **Term 2** is quickly coming to an end. Friday, January 24 will be the final day of the semester/term. Please note that our **turn around day** is **Monday, January 26**, students will **not attend** on this day unless requested to complete school work by their teacher. **Tuesday, January 27** is the beginning of **Semester 2 / Term 3**. **Course change requests are placed on-line only**. ★ **Literacy/Numeracy Assessments: As a part of the BC Ministry of Education graduation requirements**, Students in the BC Graduation Program are required to write the following graduation assessments: Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment (NME 10), Grade 10 Literacy Assessment (LTE 10) and Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment (LTE12) The assessments will be scheduled again during the week of January 12-30, 2026, as well as follow up assessments in April and June for students that will have missed or are needing to rewrite. **We will be in communication with these students who are affected, and they will be provided advanced notice**. 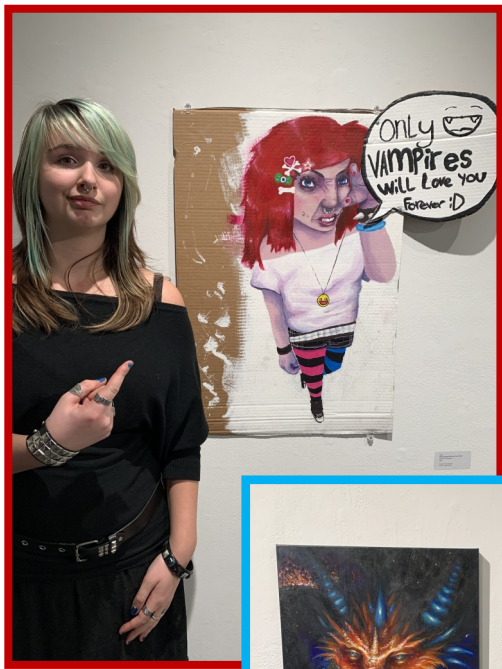


ATHLETICS:

(for kindergarten, new students, and school of choice for K – 12)

HOW TO APPLY

PLEASE NOTE: *The application process is online only. You are required to have a valid email account.*

No internet access? Please contact your school for assistance.

Online applications begin on Monday, February 2, 2026 at 7:00 am. Applications will be assigned a date-time stamp on a first-come, first-served basis, which will factor into a student's placement priority.

Complete the online application as early as possible, and provide the required documents listed below directly to the school in by email or in person by **Friday, March 13, 2026**.

1. Student's **Birth Certificate** or other government issued proof of age and citizenship.
2. **Proof of Parent/Guardian B.C. Residency**
 - a. Combination BC Driver's License and Services Card (copy of both sides); or,
 - b. BC Services Card (copy of both sides) **and** one item from the list of Supporting Documentation (3.) below; or,
 - c. Proof of application for BC Medical Services Plan and one item from the list of Supporting Documentation below.
3. **Supporting Documentation/Proof of Parent/Guardian Living Address**
 - Ownership of a dwelling or long-term lease or rental of a dwelling;
 - Documentation indicating British Columbia residence (i.e. utility bill);
 - British Columbia registration of an automobile;
 - British Columbia Driver's License (copy of both sides); or,
 - A current income tax return filed as a British Columbia resident.

AFTER Thursday, September 3, 2026

New in-catchment area enrollments: Parents will be notified by a confirmation email when the school has accepted the student's application for enrollment. Board Policy 405R – Student Placement (Regulations), will be used to determine student placement and priority.

New out-of-catchment area enrollments: Parents will not be notified until after the summer enrollment period is over and all in-catchment area students have been placed.

Qualifying age: The School Act requires that a child must be five years of age by December 31, 2026, to qualify for school enrollment in September 2026. No exceptions.
